- O Post-weld heat treatment
- Temperature Measurement
- Thermocouple attachment
- Typical Thermocouple attachment procedure
- Resistance heating
- Pipework pre-heat

Course Duration

The duration of this programme is based on the minimum credits required to attain the Unit Standard (4 credits).

Classroom time has been extended to assist in the preparation for the workplace experience: 4 days Theory and 1-day Assessment (Knowledge Questionnaire and Practical).

Then the learners continue with workplace (3 days).

Entry Requirements

It is assumed that an FEC certificate, or equivalent, has been obtained by the candidate at level 4.

(The Standard 10 /Grade 12 certificate meets these requirements).
